Ants are one of the animals mentioned by Allah in the Qur'an. Their story is found in Surah An Naml, verses 18 and 19.





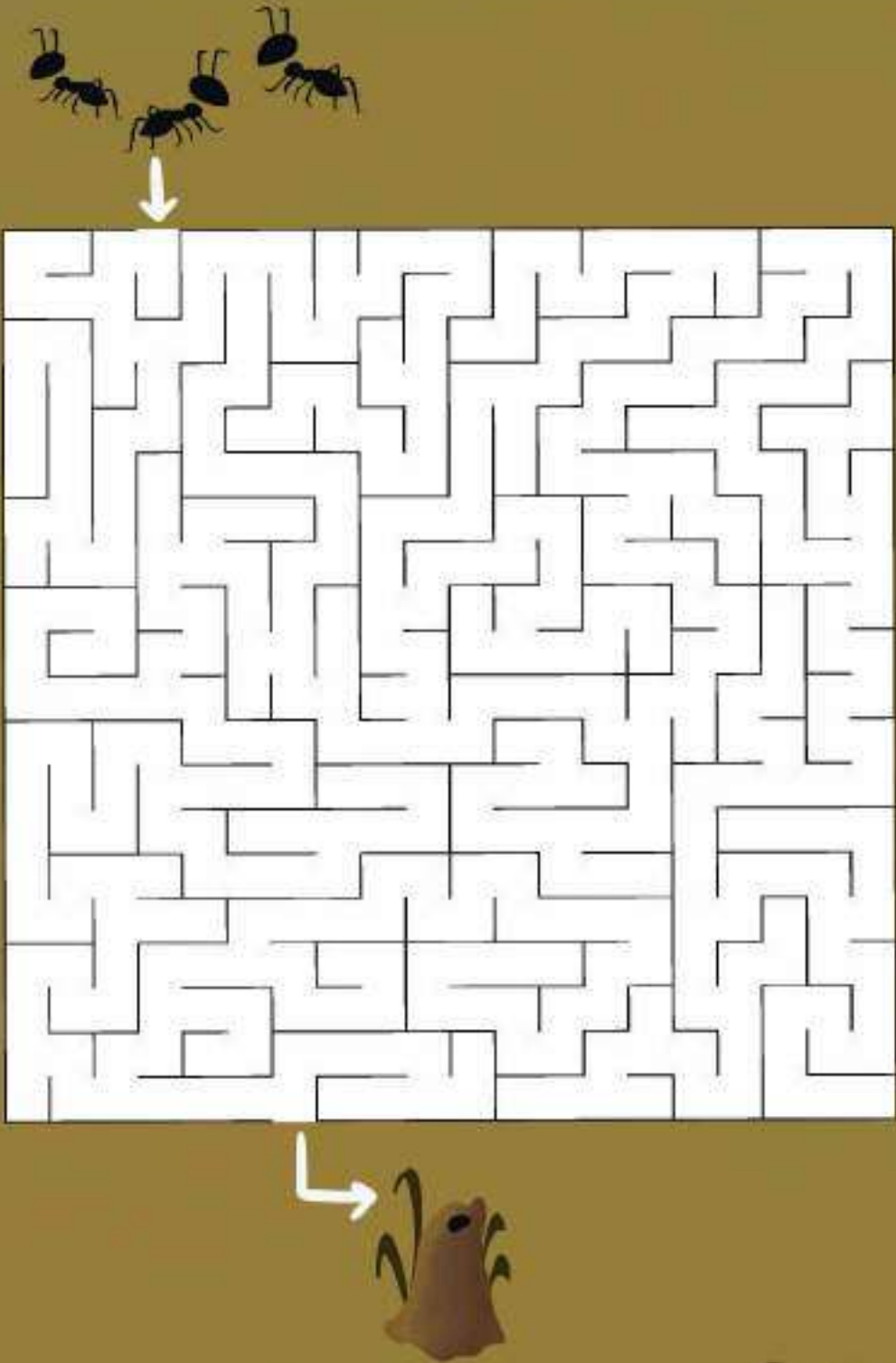
This story about ants is part of the story of Prophet Sulaiman. Prophet Sulaiman was blessed by Allah with the ability to communicate with animals.



Alhamdulillah (All praise be to Allah).



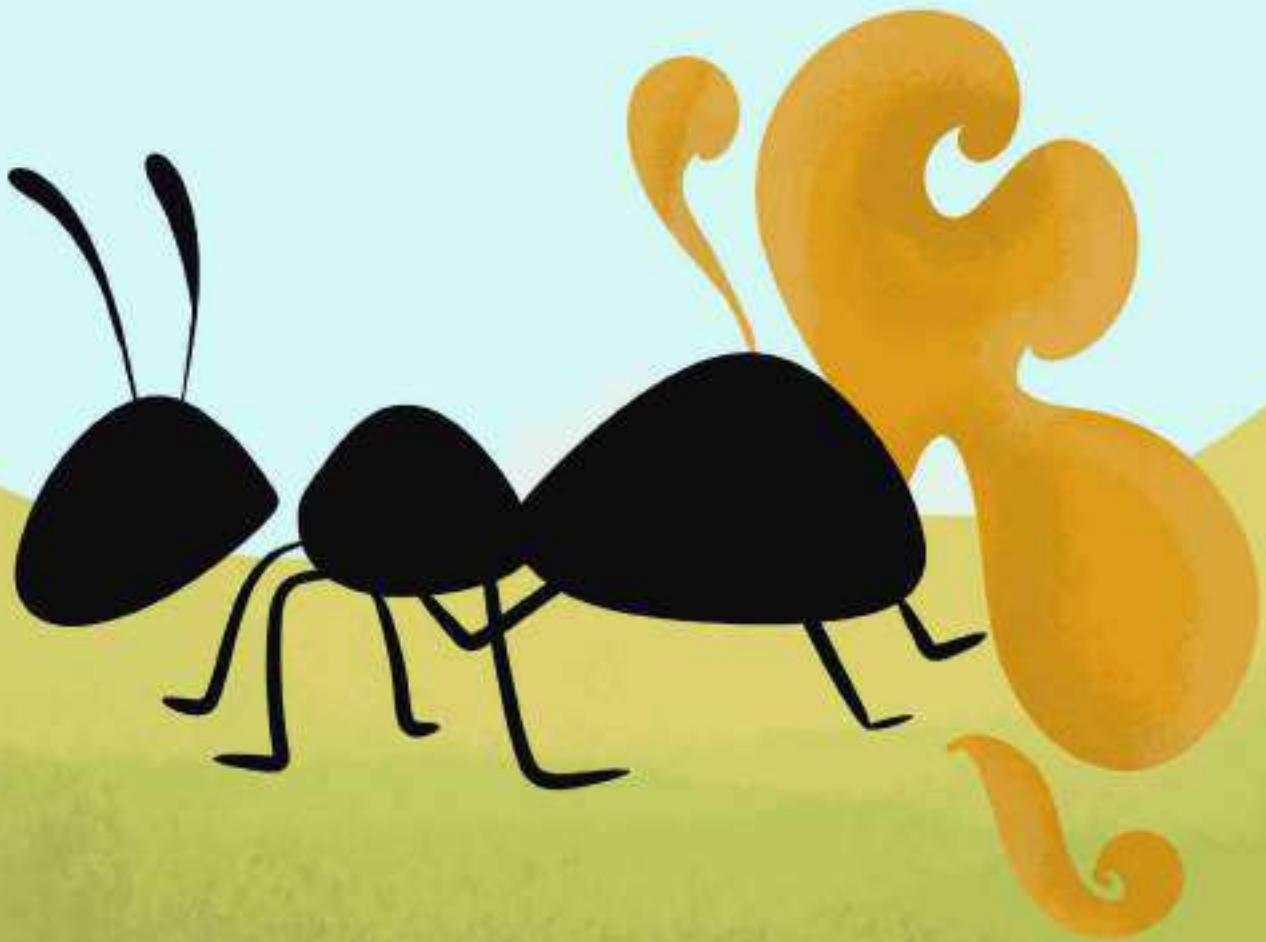


Ants are social insects, which means they live in groups. In a group, ants have different tasks. Some ants clean the nest, take care of the eggs, search for food, and some guard the nest.

Did you know?

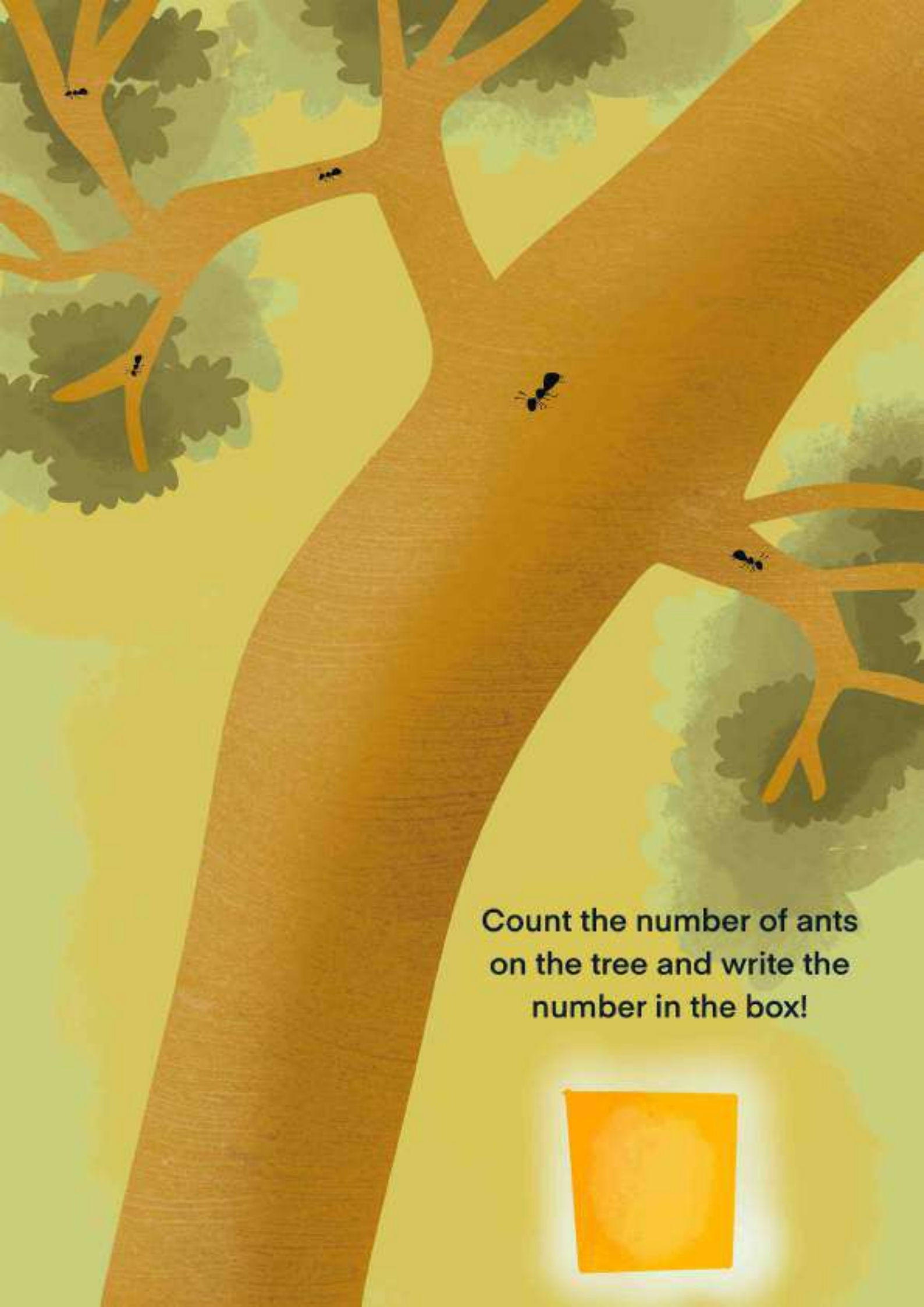
An ant can lift a load that is 20 to 50 times heavier than its own body weight.

Each group of ants has a distinct smell, which helps them recognize ants from other groups and detect intruders.



Ants usually build their nests in the ground, but some ants make their nests on trees or inside house walls.
